Heartland Wines was created by a small group of leading South Australian wine identities who are all good friends and share a passion for making great wine. The directors are second generation winemakers Ben Glaetzer and Scott Collett, fifth generation viticulturalist Geoff Hardy and wine industry professionals Grant Tilbrook and Vicki Arnold

All the wines are made by Ben Glaetzer and are made with fruit from the director's own mature vineyards in the Limestone Coast and Langhorne Creek, South Australia.



Region: 68% Langhorne Creek 32% Limestone Coast

Variety: Shiraz 100%

Vinification: The wine was pumped over twice a day and spent six days on skins. Light and heavy toasted French oak maturation for 16 months.

Tasting notes: A dark, rich purple colour. This delicious black Shiraz has hints of chocolate, menthol and tobacco leaf on the nose. Plums, blackcurrant and spice flavours abound on the palate and are perfectly balanced by fine, supple tannins.
